

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS:

Accounts that are 30 days past due will receive a reminder letter. Accounts that are 60 days past due, will receive a reminder phone call. For accounts that are 90 days past due, the student(s) will be suspended until the account is paid in full or MGA will ask the student(s) to withdraw.

FINANCIAL CLEARANCE:

Accounts must be current for the following:

- ◆ Participating in overnight trips
- ◆ Incurring additional charges
- ◆ Taking semester and final exams
- ◆ For graduation participation (grades 8 & 12), accounts must be current by the end of the 3rd quarter and be paid in full to receive diplomas.
- ◆ Cash or money orders may be required for payment on delinquent accounts.

FINANCIAL MISCELLANEOUS:

- ◆ MGA will not prorate tuition for prolonged absences when full academic credit is received.
- ◆ Monthly statements will be e-mailed to the responsible parties listed.
- ◆ Payments are due by the 15th of the month.
- ◆ MGA does not accept second party checks.
- ◆ Returned payments (NSF) may have a \$25 fee imposed.
- ◆ A history of returned checks may result in the requirement that payments be made in cash or money order only.
- ◆ Parents may start paying / prepaying on their accounts during the summer.

MID-YEAR ENROLLMENT

Charges will be incurred at the beginning of the month. Additional fees may be prorated based on grade level. Tuition adjustment may apply.

SPECIAL ENROLLMENT/ INDEPENDENT STUDY FEES

Special enrollment is for students that need 2-3 classes to round out their independent study education. Enrolled will be subject to Administration and Teacher approval and is limited if a class is 80% full. Please call the school office for further information. Discounts do not apply.

FINANCIAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Mesa Grande Academy's Board attempts to keep the school tuition and other charges as low as is consistent with good fiscal management. Tuition payments do not cover the full operating costs of MGA. **Southeastern Conference of Seventh-day Adventists and our Constituent Adventist Churches subsidize MGA.** The MGA Board reserves the right to adjust charges for tuition and fees. The following financial policies have been adopted by the Board:

PAYMENT PROCEDURE

Payments may be made by (a) cash, (b) checks (payable to **Mesa Grande Academy**) (c) vendor / bill pay through your bank (Usually free and may take 5-7 days for bank checks to reach MGA), or (d) Facts: PayNow ACH or Credit Card.

REGISTRATION

- ◆ All outstanding accounts, at MGA or other SDA schools, must be settled prior to final registration at MGA.
- ◆ Currently enrolled students are automatically enrolled for the next school year. New students will be assessed a \$50 enrollment fee.
- ◆ A processing fee of \$50 will be charged for each new student.
- ◆ Registration is not complete until the registration packet is completed and the first month's tuition is paid.

SIMPLIFIED TUITION PLAN

Mesa Grande Academy uses the Simplified Tuition Plan that is billed on the first day of each month from August to May (10 months). The monthly fee includes tuition, comprehensive fees, classroom supply, activity and local field trips (as conditions allow), Class dues for grades 8th-12th. Overnight trips for 3rd-12th grades are not included and will be billed separately, if conditions are favorable for these trips to proceed.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE / DISCOUNTS:

Please contact the Business Manager for financial assistance information. Yearly discounts, for full time students enrolled at MGA, are based on \$600 Elem, \$700 JrHi, and \$900 Acad. (Most discounts are adjusted for families that are receiving other financial assistance)

- NEW STUDENT DISCOUNT:** In the first year of enrollment, a 10% new student discount will be given.
- MULTI-FAMILY DISCOUNT:** Families with 3 or more students are eligible for a Multi-Family Discount as follows: 10% for the 3rd student, 15% for the 4th student, and 20% for the 5th student. (less any other assistance).
- ON-TIME DISCOUNT:** An On-Time Discount of \$5 per student will be given to students that are not receiving other MGA assistance when the family account is paid in full by the 15th of the month.
- REFERRAL DISCOUNT:** Students that enroll at MGA because they have been referred by a current MGA family will receive a new student discount and the referring family will receive a 10% referral discount.
- FIRST MONTH FREE TUITION:** All TK-1st students who present their **Certificate of Dedication** from one of MGA's Constituent Churches will receive a free month's tuition.
- LOW INCOME SCHOLARSHIPS:** Qualifying families may apply for assistance from the Southeastern California Conference of Seventh-day Adventist, Mesa Grande Academy, Local Church, Pacific Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventist.
- EDUCATIONAL ALLOWANCE:** If your employer offers educational allowance, you may submit your employer's educational allowance form and receive a discount.
