**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE / DISCOUNTS:**

Please contact the Business Manager for financial assistance information. Yearly discounts, for full time students enrolled at MGA, are based on \$600 Elem, \$700 JrHi, and \$900 Acad. (Most discounts are adjusted for families that are receiving other financial assistance)

1. NEW STUDENT DISCOUNT: In the first year of enrollment, a 10% new student discount will be given.
2. MULTI-FAMILY DISCOUNT: Families with 3 or more students are eligible for a Multi-Family Discount as follows: 10% for the 3rd student, 15% for the 4th student, and 20% for the 5th student. (less any other assistance).
3. REFERRAL DISCOUNT: Students that enroll at MGA because they have been referred by a current MGA family will receive a new student discount and the referring family will receive a 10% referral discount.
4. FIRST MONTH FREE TUITION: All TK-1st students who present their Certificate of Dedication from one of MGA's Constituent Churches will receive a free month's tuition.
5. LOW INCOME SCHOLARSHIPS: Qualifying families may apply for assistance from the Southeastern California Conference of Seventh-day Adventist, Mesa Grande Academy, Local Church, Pacific Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventist.
6. EDUCATIONAL ALLOWANCE: If your employer offers educational allowance, you may submit your employer's educational allowance form and receive a discount.

## **FINANCIAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

Mesa Grande Academy's Board attempts to keep the school's tuition and other charges as low as is consistent with good fiscal management. While the tuition payments do not cover our full operating costs, Southeastern Conference of Seventh-day Adventists and our Adventist Constituent Churches subsidize our operations. The MGA Board has adopted these policies and they reserve the right to make adjustments as economic conditions warrant. The annual tuition rate is billed over ten, or eleven, installments to help parents in their planning and does not signify the monthly cost of education. MGA will not prorate tuition for prolonged absences, vacations, or holidays when full academic credit is received.

## **NEW STUDENTS**

- Enrollment packets may be accessed at Mesa Grande Academy's website (MGAK-12.org) under the Admissions / New Enrollment tabs
- Parents choose a payment plan and payment method (Auto Pay or Invoice)
- New students will be assessed a \$150 enrollment fee (early enrollment discount (\$50 off) prior to March 31st)
- Registration is not complete until the registration packet is completed and the enrollment fee is paid

## **CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT**

- Currently enrolled students are automatically enrolled for the next school year unless they state their intention to withdraw by March 1.
- A \$100 "Hold My Place" deposit will be assessed March 1 and applied to the Parent's Register on August 1
- The Mesa Grande Academy Board voted to use the FACTS Tuition and Billing Management program in conjunction with our current Student Information System.
- Parents will continue to use FACTS Parent Portal to access Student Information and Finances.
- Parents will be billed for each month's tuition and incidental charges.
- Payments may be made at any time directly to FACTS, using Credit / Debit cards (fees apply) or ACH, or by check (payable to Mesa Grande Academy) or cash to the Office.
- Parents choose a payment plan and payment method (Auto Pay or Invoice) and registration will be considered complete upon the payment of the first month's tuition
